GENERAL INFORMATION

STALLS & RV INFORMATION

Stall and RV Reservations must be made by contacting the Idaho Horse Park directly at 208-442-3335 or online at https://www.fordidahocenter.com/horse-park-sports-center/stall-rv-reservations. Both Stall and RV reservations open on Monday, September 23, 2024 at 9am/MST. Stalls are \$250 for the entire show or \$55 per day per stall. Shavings are also available to order through the Horse Park office.

PRACTICE PEN

An outdoor cow work practice pen will be available Wednesday, October 30- Saturday November 2nd **WEATHER PERMITTING**. Priority Work pen(s) will run the same day the class shows. Additional works may be scheduled after the priority works for that set have completed. Practice pen works will be billed to the show tab. Cow work practices are \$65. The arenas will have open riding time when classes have ended for the day. A schedule with exact times will be posted prior to the show. This is subject to change based on arena prep needed and weather.

VETERINARIAN

Idaho Equine Hospital is the Official Veterinarian of the IRCHA and is located directly South of the Horse Park. The hospital can be reached at 208-466-4613.

HEALTH DOCUMENTS

ALL Out of state horses, including noncompete horses, will require a negative Coggins (Equine Infectious Anemia) dated within 12 months of the event, and a health certificate dated within 10 days. ALL horses, including noncompete horses, are required to be checked in at the IRCHA Show Office.

PHOTOGRAPHER

IRCHA Official Photographer is Rockin Horse Photography. Photo booth is available to view your photos free of charge located directly across from the grandstand stairs. Awards photos may be taken by individuals at the photo setup attached to the warm up pen with no scheduling. Champion Arena Award photos will be held directly after the respective class unless announced differently at the show according to scheduling.



GENERAL INFORMATION

VIDEOGRAPHER

IRCHA Official Videographer is Raindancer Video. Immediately following your run, you are able to view your run on the replay monitor at no charge. The monitor will be set up adjacent to the indoor warm up area. You may also visit Raindancer's trailer located next to grandstand stairs to rewatch your runs free of charge. You may purchase your videos from Raindancer and contact information will be provided at his trailer.

MEDIA POLICY

Visitors, spectators and exhibitors at IRCHA events are permitted to take photographs and record video for personal use only. Visitors, spectators and exhibitors are strictly prohibited from taking photographs and video for commercial distribution, including printed publications, web sites, social networking sites or similar media. This policy applies to, but not limited to, competition arenas; warm up arenas; barn and stall areas; and cattle facilities. Media representatives with IRCHA approved credentials are the only exception to this policy.

Professional photography equipment, such as cameras with lenses longer than 4 inches, tripods, monopods, or any video camera mounted on a tripod or other stabilizing device, is not permitted. The only exceptions are media representatives with IRCHA-approved credentials.

The IRCHA Official Photographer Rockin Horse Photography, and the IRCHA Official Videographer Raindancer Video, are the only authorized outlets for competition photos or videos. The IRCHA will eject and/or indefinitely ban from its events anyone who provides, or intends to use, photo or video footage in violation of this policy.

ENTRY INFORMATION

FUTURITY & DERBY

All class eligibility is governed by the **NRCHA 2024 Rulebook.** Contestants are entirely responsible for knowing their level of eligibility and entering accordingly.

Level 1 Open and Novice Horse ONLY entries will be a separate draw from the Open. If you cross enter from the Open into the L1O or Novice Horse, you will be drawn with the Open. \$1500 Novice Horse (Futurity only) horse cannot have won over \$1,500 during current futurity year. New this year, the IRCHA is offering the Limited Non Pro Futurity and Derby class.

- Entries due on/before Friday, 10/18/24, or a \$100 late fee will be assessed.
- Draw date is Tuesday, 10/22/24 in the morning if you enter after 10/22/24 you will be drawn first or last in a set at the discretion of the IRCHA and a late fee assessed.
- LAE Late entries will be accepted until noon the day before the class begins. Late
 fees will be charged to any entry received after the entry deadline. Late Entries
 received after the draw will be drawn first or last in a set at the discretion of the
 IRCHA. Late fees are not charged to add classes or divisions to the original entry
 that was on time for that horse, AND before the draw.
- SCRATCH POLICY: Deadline to scratch with no fees is Monday, 10/21/24 <u>before</u> 10pm/MT
 - Scratch after the deadline, but before the draw Responsible for cattle fee and office fee
 - Scratch after the draw All fees except NRCHA and Video fees must be paid.

HORSE SHOW

All class eligibility is governed by the **NRCHA 2024 Rulebook.** Contestants are entirely responsible for knowing their level of eligibility and entering accordingly.

- Must enter before **noon the day before** the class, or a \$100 late fee will be assessed and you will be drawn first or last in a set at the discretion of the IRCHA.
- SCRATCH POLICY: Deadline to scratch with no fees is 1:00 pm the day before class
 - Scratch after the deadline, but before the draw Responsible for cattle and office fee
 - Scratch after the draw All fees except NRCHA and Video fees must be paid.

ENTRY INFORMATION

ENTRIES

You can enter online at www.idahoreinedcowhorse.com/2024-futurity-derby-horse via the online entry form. A credit card number is REQUIRED to process and hold the entry. Your card will not be run until check out and you can choose to pay with a check at the show. Please see SHOW RULES for payment policy.

Providing a Social Security Number is mandatory for any earning checks to be processed. Missing or incomplete entries will not be processed.

- All check payments are made to IRCHA. Payment by credit card will have a processing fee of 4% added.
- Any payments that come back to IRCHA for lack of funds will be charged an additional fee of \$20
- Provided credit card numbers and checks will not be charged or deposited until your show bill has been closed at the show office. This is to hold your entry.
- If you do not close out your show bill, it will be closed for you utilizing the payment method provided on your entry.
- If refunds are owed, IRCHA will issue a check to the payee unless otherwise directed. Refunds are issued within 10 business days of the conclusion of the show.

COWBOY CLASS

TERMS & CONDITIONS

The 2024 Cowboy Class held at the 2024 IRCHA Futurity, Derby, and Horse Show is open to cowboys who have earned less than \$15,000 in Open and Non Pro money at NRCHA events other than the Cowboy Class, and are currently employed by ranching/livestock operations. Exhibitors must indicate the name of the ranching/livestock operation that they currently work for at the time of entry. The Cowboy Class includes reined work, cow work, and modified steer stopping. Horses will be shown in the same age appropriate NRCHA legal equipment throughout all phases. No tie-downs will be permitted. Equipment will be checked after each go-round. A score of zero will be given for illegal equipment or bloody mouth on the horse. Scoring of the reined and cow portions of this contest will be in accordance with NRCHA rules. It will be at Show Management's discretion if the reined and cow work are run back-to-back or separately. The modified steer stopping will be run separately from the reined and cow work and will utilize the Steer Stopping Judge Card. Modified steer stopping will be run as a walk-out roping and will not utilize a chute or barrier. NRCHA rules and regulations will apply in all other instances. The rein, cow and steer stopping for the Cowboy Class will be drawn on Wednesday, October 30, 2024.

REFUND POLICY

The IRCHA Horse Show Refund Policy requires scratches to be made in writing and received in the IRCHA office or by emailing info@horseshowpros.com.

- Scratches made on or before the due date will not be charged
- Scratches made after the due date but before the draw will be charged the office fee as retainage
- Scratches made after the draw will be charged all fees with the exception of the NRCHA fee(s) and video fee

ADDED MONEY

SHOW RULES

ANIMAL WELFARE

The Idaho Reined Cow Horse Association takes seriously the welfare of the equine partners and the cattle that allow for participation in our sanctioned events. Animal use is deeply ingrained in our society, benefiting the health of people, supporting commerce, and enhancing our enjoyment of life. IRCHA acknowledges the valuable role of these animal partners in our lives, in history and in horse shows and is committed to providing a proper environment for them in competition, in transport and at rest, and to providing humane guidelines for care and treatment of both horses and cattle. Inhumane treatment of the equine partners we ride or the cattle vital to our competition is not acceptable and anyone observed violating the welfare of these animals will be immediately ejected.

PAYMENT POLICY

All entries for the IRCHA Futurity, Derby and Horse Show must be accompanied by a form of payment. Entries **WILL NOT BE PROCESSED** without a form of payment. A credit card is required with entry. Upon check-in you can provide a check in the Horse Show Office. At checkout you can pay with check or credit card. In the event that no charges are incurred during the event, your check will be returned to you. Any practice pen charges will be added to your show tab.

All show tabs MUST be closed out at the horse show. Show office reserves the right to close your tab via the payment method on file at end of business the day you are done showing. Should your account be closed out using the card on file and you wish to change payment to a check, credit card fees will not be returned. Payments using a credit card will incur a 4% fee. Any NSF checks or credit cards will be charged a \$20 NSF fee. Any tabs that are not paid in full at the end of the show (including scratched entries) will be charged a \$50 late fee*.

PAYOUT REQUIREMENTS

In order to receive your win checks from the show, you must have a current W-9 on file with the IRCHA Office. W-9's can be filled out in the Horse Show Office shortly after the class has ended. You will not be able to receive your check without a current W-9 on file with the IRCHA.
